Sower House Shoppe and Tea Room-County Road 900 North, Rome City

The Sower House Shoppe and Tea Room is set in a stunning historic Italianate-style home nestled in a picturesque spot along the road to the Gene Stratton Porter State Memorial, just a stone's throw from Sylvan Lake. The house was built in 1888 by the Sower family and is located adjacent to the Gene Stratton-Porter State Historic Site in Rome City. Gene Stratton-Porter stayed at the site while her cabin on Sylvan Lake was being built. The house retains all original woodwork and pocket doors from the 1880s. It was previously rescued from demolition and rehabbed by Indiana Landmarks and the Noble County Convention and Visitors Bureau through a partnership with the State of Indiana. It will soon open as a General Store featuring Indiana-made goods and snacks for nearby trail users, among other visitor services. Our Tea Room is expected to open for booking in late November or December.

Directions from town hall Go south on Hwy 9 about .7 miles Turn left on E County Road 900 North. Go about .8 miles and the Sower House will be on your left, just past the curve in the road.

Home of: Scott & Rhonda Stienecker -1205 Hilltop, Rome City

Scott & Rhonda Stienecker moved from Lima, Ohio, to 1205 Hilltop Dr. on Sylvan Lake in 2018. They looked at many houses and finally found their dream home. Their criteria included elevation above the lake, enough square footage for family and friends to visit, and incredible lake views. They walked into the house and knew they were home. The prior owner kept the original cabin and added to it over the years. In essence, it was two different houses connected, each with their own character. Scott and Rhonda wanted to keep the charm of the cabin but also update the house to make it feel like home. Many people did not know the house existed as it was hidden by a large canopy of trees. The house and site had a good foundation, and with a little work, this house could be spectacular.

The first project was removing trees and improving the foundation and exterior by building a large deck. Updating the inside started the second phase. They kept the charm of the second-floor cabin the same but updated the kitchen on the first floor. They moved the laundry and utility room from the center of the house with a lake view to an unused bedroom and created a new lake-facing dining area. The large living room was gutted and replaced with an updated living room/second kitchen. The last project of 2024 was putting in a new large window coming down the stairs to give a view of beautiful Sylvan Lake. Scott and Rhonda love living on their peaceful street and enjoy spending time with wonderful neighbors. They are so thankful for the many great friends they have made.

Directions from town hall Go south on Hwy 9 about 0.7 miles Turn left on E County Road 900 North. Go about 0.7 miles and turn left on Hilltop Drive. Take Hilltop to the right and the home will be on your left just as you go right on Hilltop.





Home of: David and Christine Harges 1255 Hiltop, Rome City

Welcome to 1255 Hilltop! This piece of land is practically a sibling to me, as I am an only child of my parents, Lee & Sanna Harges, who acquired it when I was just two years old. In April of 1974, my dad was suddenly asked by a friend if he would be interested in buying the property. My dad said yes, and within a few weeks, the property was purchased. Just prior to that, a tornado had passed over Sylvan Lake, taking down the owner's house that had stood on the island attached to the property.

When my parents took possession, all that remained was a cement staircase on the hill that led to the water, a destroyed foot-bridge that had previously connected the mainland to the island, and a skeleton of the house that once called the island "home." Everything else had been blown into the water.

For my mom and dad (and me), the summer of 1974 began what would be a thirty-year-long "labor of love." Soon after, my parents bought a small camper, parked it at the top of the hill, and each summer, we worked endlessly to improve the property by first cleaning up after the tornado, building a new bridge to the island, and then building a garage at the top of the hill. By the late 1980s, we had finally built the house that now stands. In 2004, thirty years after the tornado, we added on to the house with a game room, bedroom, hot tub room, and new garage.

Unfortunately, my mom passed in 2016, and my dad is no longer able to live at the house. But together with my wife Christine, my sons Aidan & Tristan, and my mom's sister Bea, we have continued my parent's vision for the property.

In 2018, the entire hillside went through a transformation in landscaping, and in the spring of 2024, a two-year-long renovation of the house was completed. This renovation, done in large part by Roberta Stone and Jason Teders, took the home from a 3 bed/3 bath 1990s style house to a 5 bed/4 bath rustic modern with beautiful live-edge furniture. It is also decorated with photographs of the surrounding area by Christine and myself.

Over the last 50 years it has truly been a "labor of love" for our entire family, and we all are so proud of what it has become. We look forward to sharing it with you during the Holiday House Walk, and we are now also offering it as a short-term-rental for families to enjoy themselves.
